

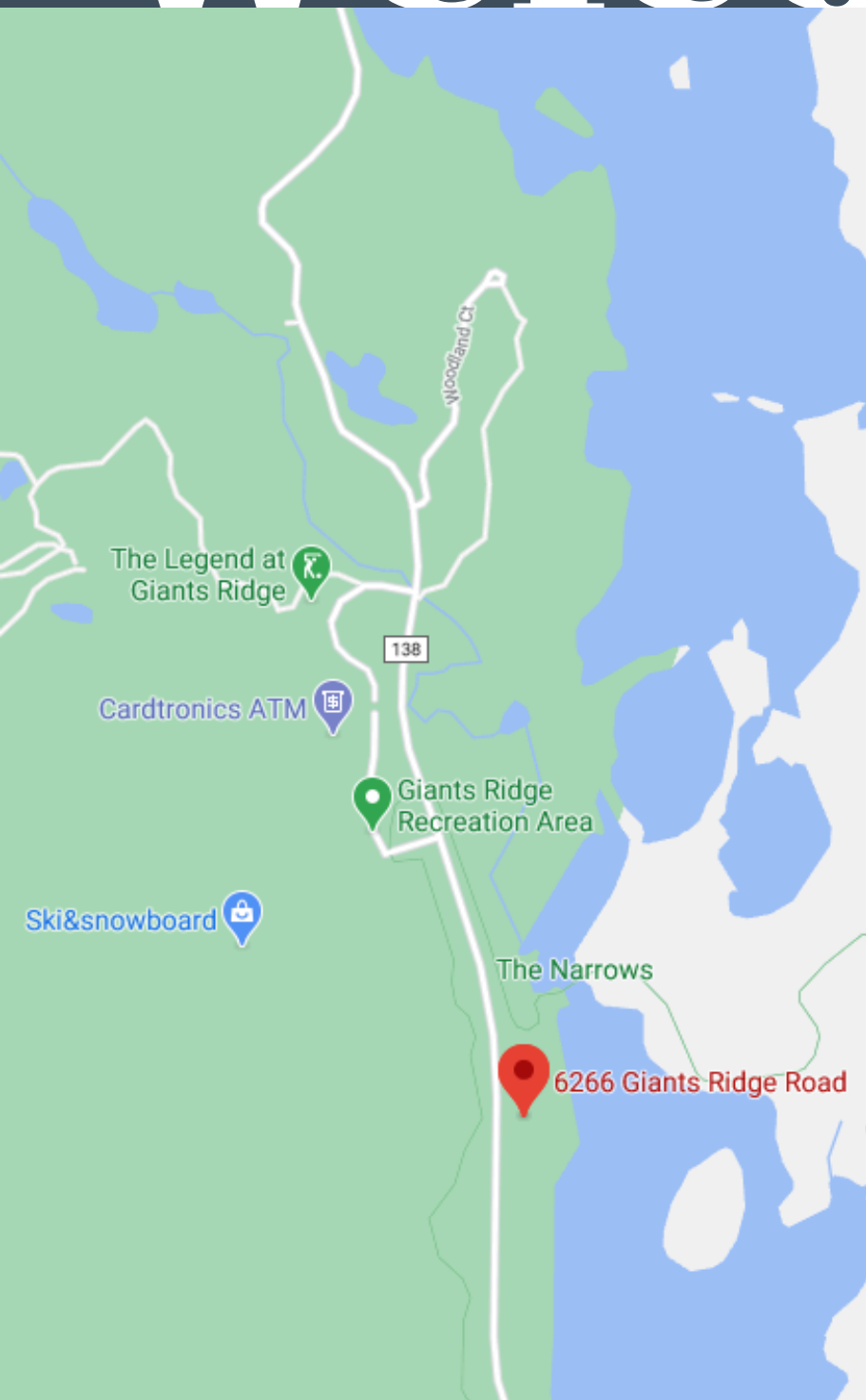

CHECK-IN

Check-in time is any time after 4PM.

Access to The Hygge Suite is via a keypad on the door. We will send you the code via the booking platform on the morning of your stay. Enter that code and the door will unlock.

PARKING

Parking is available on both sides of the property. See the map later in the guide for annotated details.

CHECK-OUT

Check-out is by 11AM.

We do ask a few things of you to help us:

- Leave dirty towels in bathtub
- Empty the refrigerator
- Load and start the dishwasher
- Take out trash to bins outside the front door
- Start the washer with any used dog blankets
- Log out of any TV accounts (e.g. Netflix)
- Lock the front and back doors

in the suite

television

There's a 50" smart TV in the lounge, offering free cable TV, and various smart apps you can log into with your own accounts such as Netflix, YouTube etc. There are 2 remotes in the basket under the TV, the small Roku remote is for the main TV and smart apps, the larger MediaCom remote is for cable TV channels only.

front door

To open the front door, key in the code we sent to you and the door will unlock.

To lock the door, press the lock symbol (the door does not lock on its own).

fireplace

There's a gas fireplace in the lounge. To turn it on, press the button on the right of the frame. If you don't hear gas, and / or it fails to light, turn it off then on again until it does ignite.

ac & heat

There is HVAC throughout the property with a Nest thermostat next to the dining area. Just turn the dial to change the temperature.

trash

Trash is collected regularly from the large trash can at the front of the property. There is no recycling.

safety first

There are several safety features / considerations to make your stay as safe as possible:

- There are smoke / carbon monoxide detectors in the suite (in the lounge, and in the bedroom).
- There is a security camera at the front of the property and noise decibel monitoring inside the property.
- The fireplace glass gets hot, so please be careful.
- The front and back doors do not automatically lock.

in the suite

device charging

The bedside lights have USB-A ports.

The kitchen has a USB-A & USB-C outlet behind the sofa, perfect for phones and tablets (bring your own charger for USB-C powered laptops as these draw higher power than the USB-C outlet provides).

babies

We've provided some essentials so you can feel safe and travel light:

- Tamper resistant power outlets
- Pack and play
- High chair
- Blackout drapes

fur babies

If your babies are of the furry variety, we've got them covered too.

- Dog bowls for food & water
- Dog blankets
- Dog treats

These can all be found in the cleaning closet. Please wash any dog blankets and bowls after use.

supplies

We've provided all the essentials so you're ready to go on day one (note that daily housekeeping / replenishment of supplies are not provided).

- Toiletries
- Towels
- Laundry detergent
- Keurig Pods & a selection of Teas
- Salt & Pepper
- Oil
- Sugar & Sweetener
- Hand soap
- Dishwasher tablets & dish soap
- Bed linens & pillows
- Vacuum, dust pan and brush, mop, cleaning products

ski closet

We provided a few storage solutions for your skis or boards.

- Ski rack - holds 2 sets of skis and their poles
- Snowboard rack - holds 2 standard width snowboards
- Two racks for gloves & goggles

in the suite

laundry

There is a washer / dryer in the bathroom closet as well as laundry pods / dryer sheet. Instructions on how to use the appliances are on the machine.

kitchen appliances

The kitchen is well stocked with essentials & gadgets.

- Fridge freezer & water purifier (inside the fridge)
- Keurig coffee machine
- Toaster
- Kettle
- Microwave (built-in)
- Electric oven
- Dishwasher
- All pots, pans and dishes

food storage

There is a mid-sized fridge freezer in the kitchen area, suitable for storing multiple days of food and drink.

Dry food storage is available via a single cupboard on the right side of the microwave - suitable for multiple days of food, however not large enough for significant volumes of food or large containers - you can use the kitchen workshop for larger items.

guitar

Play to your heart's content, but please be respectful of neighbors and quiet hours.



some things to note

automatic porch lights

The porch light at the front of the property is on a sunset to sunrise timer, so no need to switch it on/off. You obviously can turn it off each night if you wish via the switch by the front door.

dishwasher

If the dishwasher fails to complete the cycle, run the hot water faucet in the kitchen sink until the water runs hot, then try the dishwasher again - the failure may be because no hot water is being drawn by the dishwasher as it pulls colder water from the pipes instead.

whirlpool tub

There's a whirlpool tub in the bathroom. Please ensure the jets are fully submerged before turning it on to avoid burning out the jets.

recycling

Unfortunately there is no recycling option as the resort does not have recycling waste collection.



communal areas

welcome center

The opening hours vary (see door of the welcome center for up-to-date hours), or contact them at 218-865-4155.

pool & hot tub

The pool and hot tub are typically open May through September, weather dependent. Bathroom and shower facilities are located in the welcome center (next to the pool). No lifeguard is present. The code for this area is sent with the door code.

tennis

A tennis court is outside the front of The Hygge Suite. Tennis rackets should be in the activities closet (near the front door).

playground

There's a playground next to the beach. The play area is not monitored so don't leave children unattended.

wynne lake

Wynne Lake is right behind The Hygge Suite. Equipment rental including kayaks, canoes, paddles boards and paddle boats are available from the welcome center - pricing is ~\$35 per hour with a 2 hour max (first come, first served basis).

fire pits

Fire wood is available for purchase at the Welcome Center. Reminder to not leave a fire put unattended, and ensure fires are fully extinguished before you leave the area.

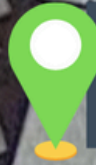
grills

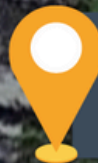

MAIN ENTRANCE

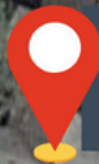

house rules

pets

We know your furry friends are going to love their stay. We have a few house rules we ask you to follow:

- Dogs must be kept on a leash around The Villas, and all pet waste disposed of.
- Dogs are not allowed on the furniture. If you are leaving dogs unattended, please ensure the sofa is covered with blankets (provided) and the bedroom door closed to avoid any additional cleaning fees.
- We charge a flat fee of \$100 per stay for pets, this is to cover the cost of extra cleaning. Any damage caused may result in extra charges.

noise

The resort quiet time is 10pm to 8am daily. We use privacy noise monitoring software within the suite. If a noise complaint is received, or we monitor excessive noise, you may be asked to vacate the property with no refunds. Excessive pet noise may also result in a fine and management asking you to take your pet to a local kennels.

smoking

In an attempt to maintain a pleasant environment for all our guests, no smoking is allowed in the suite. If evidence of smoking is found, a fee of up to \$250 may be charged to cover extra cleaning.



house rules

bikes

Giants Ridge is a great place to bring your bikes, however there are a few things to know before your arrival:

- Bikes are not allowed inside the property, due to limited space and possible damages to the walls.
- The best place to lock your bike up is at the rear of the property, where you can attach a bike lock to the wooden deck railings - this area is hidden from the road.
- We don't provide bike locks, so please bring your own lock. If you need a bike lock, Target / Walmart have good options.
- There is a basic bike repair kit in the activities closet - if you use an item, please let us know so we can ensure its replaced for other guests.
- Bikes are left at your own risk.

TRAILS

- Sleeping Giant Hiking Trail: ~3 miles.
